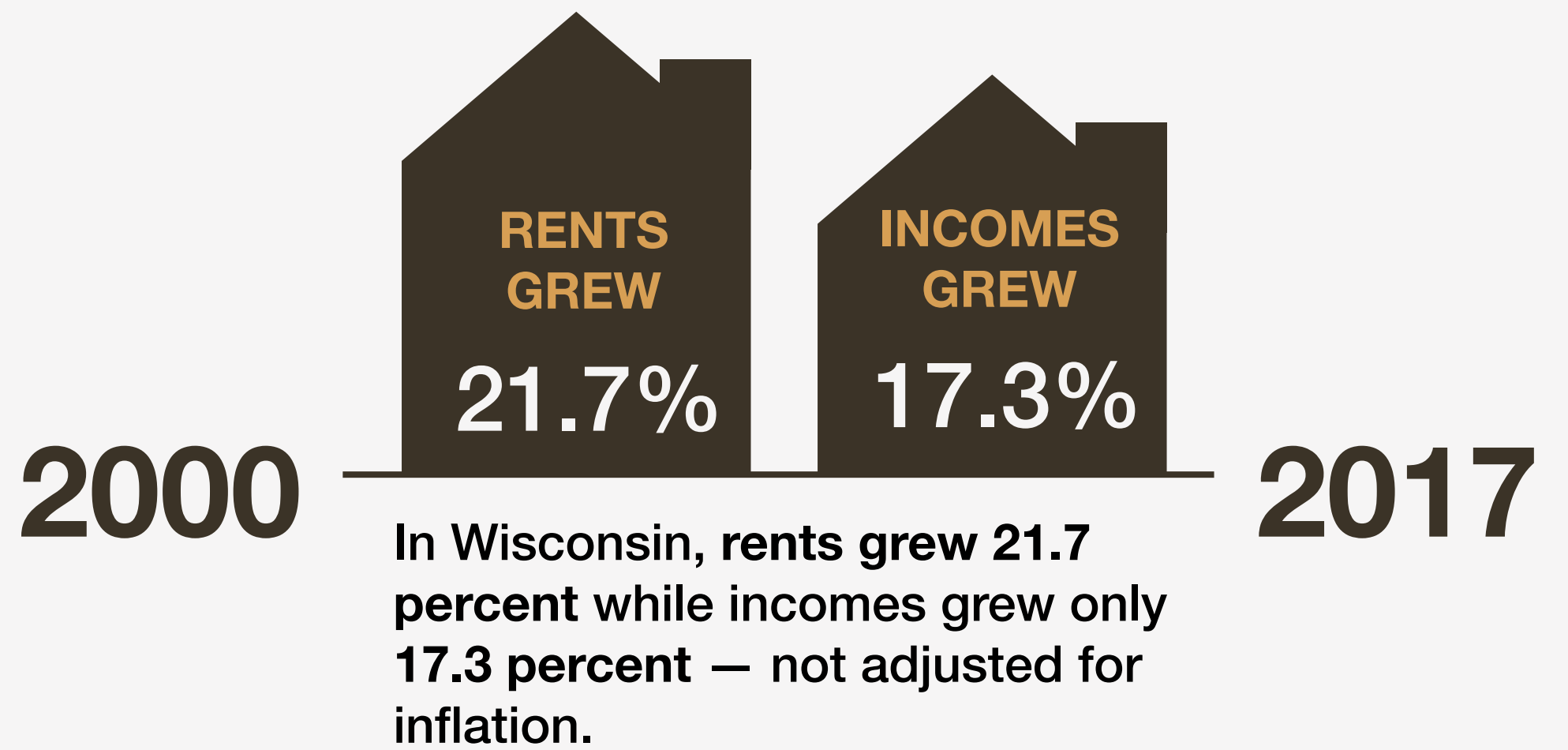


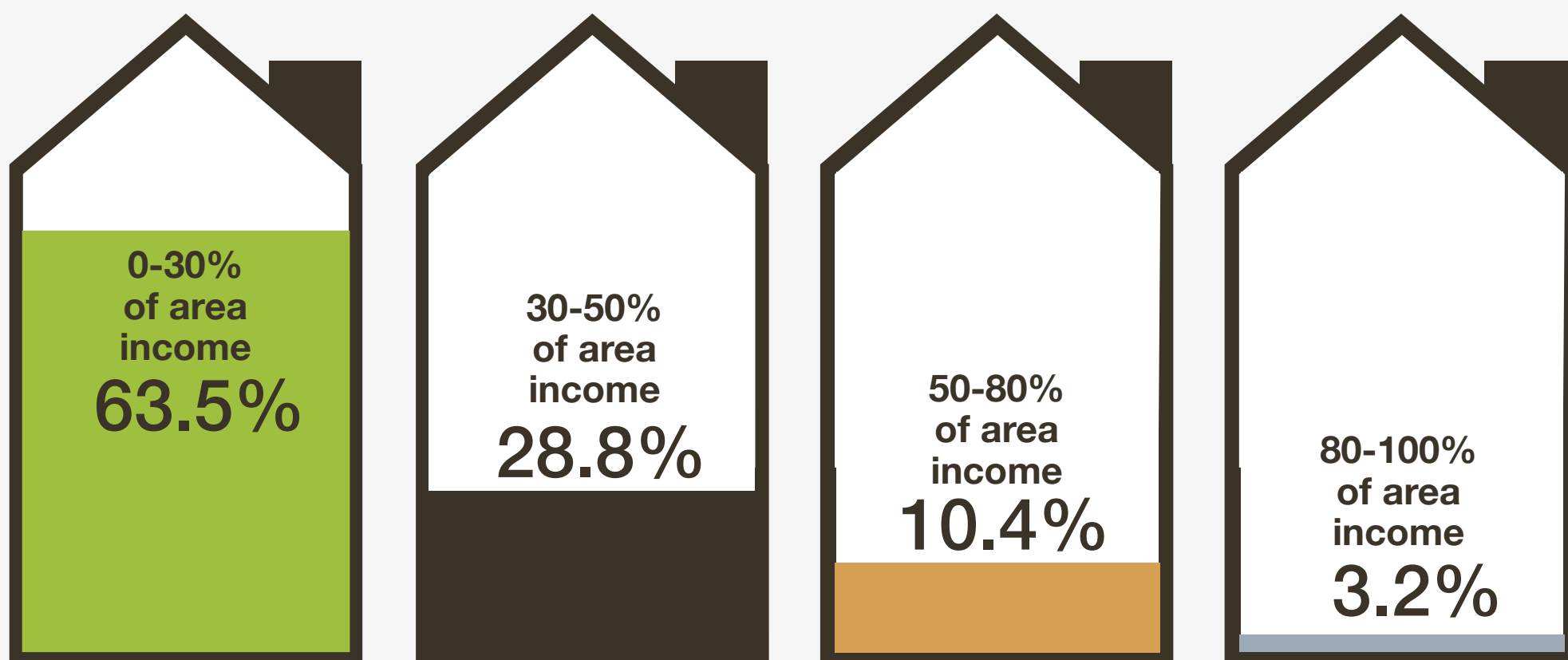
# EFFECTS OF THE WORKFORCE HOUSING SHORTAGE ON HOMEOWNERS AND RENTERS

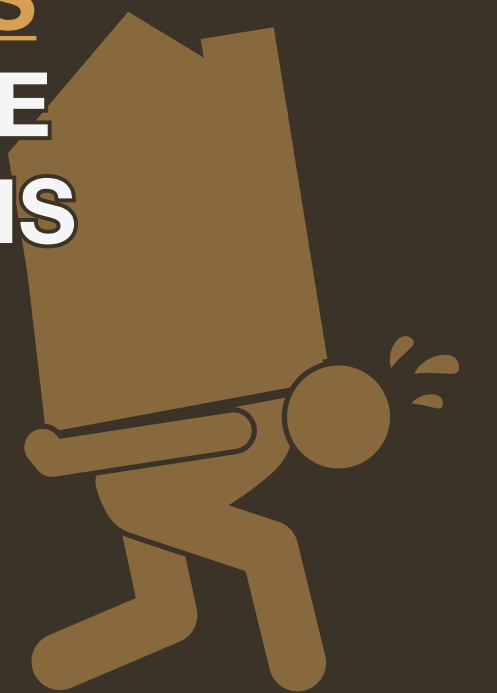
Percent of Wisconsin homeowners “extremely cost-burdened,” by income category



In Wisconsin, over 94,000 homeowners whose income is below 50 percent of area median income spend more than half of their income on housing.

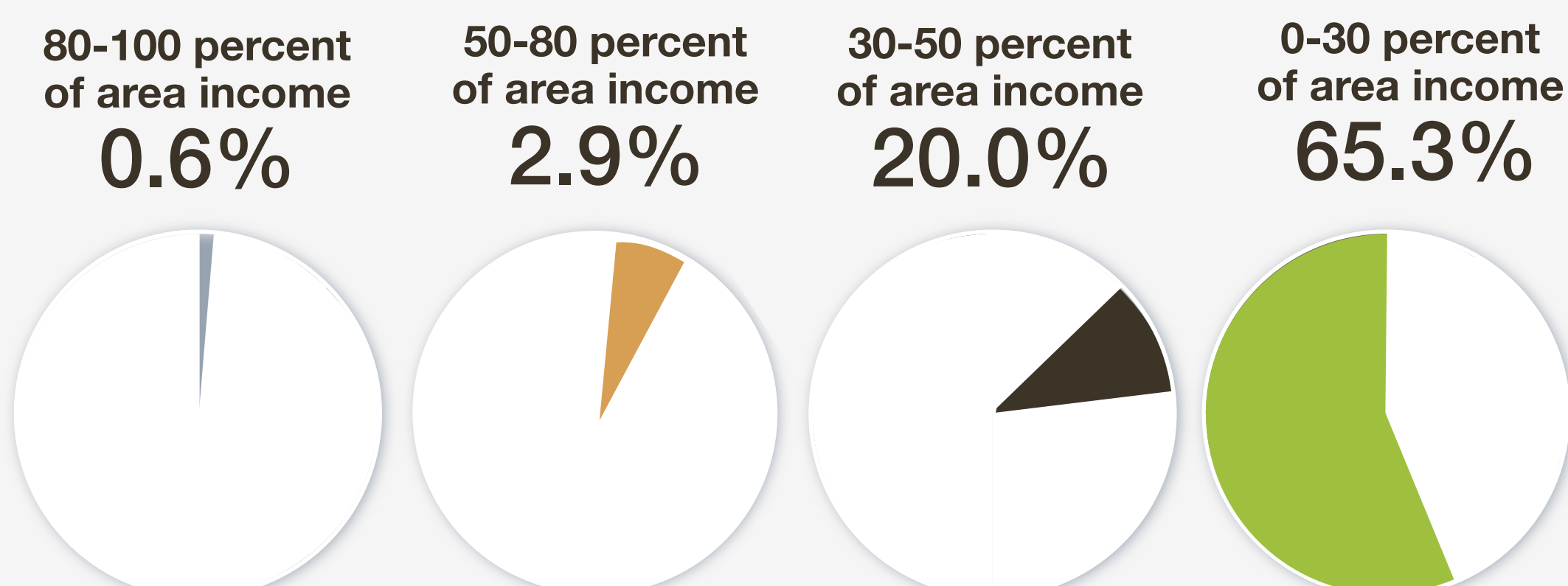
